

9TH STREET PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE
Medford, Oregon



The bridge spans Bear Creek beneath the I-5 freeway viaduct and connects the pedestrian/bike path and adjacent parking with the central downtown business district. Our team consulted with the various agencies to meet riparian requirements for construction of this project and provide a safe pedestrian passage.

The resulting design reconfigures adjacent parking areas and integrates these with interesting path-way paving and design detailing that will be a signature for the community.
